

The Hoyt City Council met in special session on July 29, 2026.

Present were Mayor Robert Bell and council members Debbie Dreasher, Larry Valdez, Joe Romans and Rebecca McClane. Council member Leonard Allen was absent. Also present was city attorney Tom Barnes. Garrett Nordstrom with Governmental Assistance Services briefly appeared by phone.

Mayor Robert Bell called the meeting to order at 6:25 p.m.

Council discussed the status of the easements needed for the sidewalk project.

City attorney had walked and reviewed some of the proposed sidewalk area with council member McClane and Mayor Bell and after reviewing the county maps believed the proposed sidewalk appeared to be within the city's right of way. This was also discussed with Garrett Nordstrom (Nordstrom appeared by phone). The city attorney will follow up with the engineers to see why they had included certain properties on the list of needed easements. City attorney would like to obtain a copy of the original platted survey for the city.

Rebecca McClane relayed the tribe had large concrete blocks that could be donated for use in the city park if interested. The clerk can check with Kenny Bryan.

Council discussed with the city attorney the budget workshop meeting set for August 4, 2026.

Joe Romans made a motion to adjourn. Larry Valdez seconded, motion carried.
